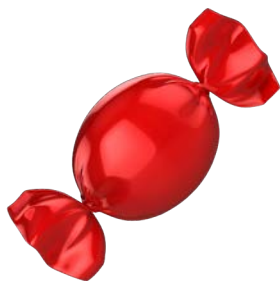


Annual Candy Hunt

HOHA End of Summer Bash/ Picnic August 9, 5:00-8:00 p.m.

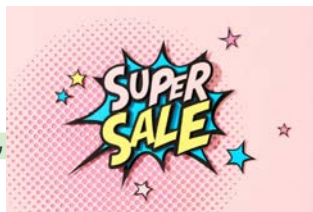

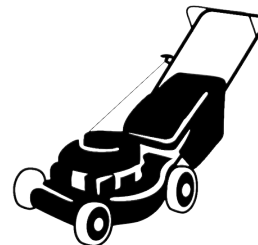

Traffic and Parking Guidelines

According to the City of Omaha's Code of Ordinance, section 36-161, cars can't be parked on residential streets without movement for 48 hours.

Sec. 36-161. - Storage of cars on street. No person shall park a vehicle continuously in one place in the same block for a period in excess of 48 hours on any street, and any vehicle parked in violation of this section is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

If cars are parked for extended periods of time, this causes traffic problems and the streets can't be cleaned of snow properly.

To report a vehicle, call the Mayor's Hotline, (402) 444-5555.
